1. When and Where

How Many Days Should You Plan For?

Minimum (2 days - Friday to Saturday): Arrive Friday afternoon to pick up credentials and explore the exhibition hall, attend the Saturday meeting, and fly out Saturday evening or Sunday morning.

Recommended (3-5 days - Wednesday/Thursday to Sunday): This allows time for investing conferences Thursday and Friday, the Borsheims shopping event Friday evening, the full Saturday meeting, the NFM gathering Saturday afternoon, the 5K on Sunday, and restaurants and sightseeing.

Full Immersion (6+ days): For those who want to attend multi-day programs. Some begin as early as the Sunday before the meeting.

PRO TIP

If you only have one day, Saturday is the core event. If you want the full Omaha experience, arriving by Thursday or Friday morning opens up significantly more networking and conference opportunities.

2. How to Get Tickets

Admission to the CHI Health Center for the annual meeting requires official meeting credentials (shareholder badges). These are provided to shareholders at no cost.

2.1 Pre-Ordering Credentials

Each spring (typically mid-March), Berkshire distributes its Annual Report, Proxy Statement, and Credential Request Form to shareholders. Each shareholder has historically been entitled to request up to four (4) credentials.

General process (based on recent years):

- Shareholders holding shares directly typically receive materials by mail.
- Shareholders holding shares through a brokerage typically receive proxy materials and credential request instructions from their broker.
- Requests are submitted online or by mail per the form's instructions.
- The deadline has typically fallen in mid-April.
- Pre-ordered credentials are generally mailed in April.

Start here: Check the [official Berkshire Hathaway annual meeting page](#) for the most current process and deadlines.

PRO TIP

Request credentials as soon as forms become available. If you wait too long, you may need to pick them up at Will Call in Omaha. Keep a clean PDF of your proof-of-ownership ready.

2.2 Will Call Pickup in Omaha

If you didn't pre-order or your credentials didn't arrive in time, Will Call has historically been available at the CHI Health Center:

- **Location:** CHI Health Center Omaha lobby
- **Typically required:** Photo ID and proof of share ownership (such as a brokerage statement showing BRK.A or BRK.B holdings)

Hours and requirements may change. Confirm with official sources.

PRO TIP

Pick up credentials Friday if you can. Saturday morning is when everything stacks: lines, security, seating, and crowds.

2.3 Do You Need to Be a Shareholder?

The credential system is built for Berkshire Hathaway shareholders. Owning at least one share - including a single Class B share (BRK.B) - has been sufficient to request credentials.

Options for non-shareholders:

- Each shareholder has historically been able to request up to four credentials, so a shareholder friend or family member may be able to obtain a guest pass for you.
- Many of the week's independent side events do not require Berkshire credentials.
- The Saturday Q&A is typically available via a free live stream at [cnbc.com/brklive](https://www.cnbc.com/brklive).

PRO TIP

Purchasing one BRK.B share through a standard brokerage well before March is generally the most straightforward path to credentials.

3. Events Calendar

The meeting week features a packed calendar of official Berkshire-affiliated events plus dozens of independently organized conferences, dinners, and meetups. Below is the most comprehensive independently compiled listing for 2026.

Several of the weekend's best events are completely free but fill up fast. Look for the ones marked "Free (RSVP required)" below and register early to secure your spot.

Always confirm individual event details with the organizer's website. Dates, times, prices, and availability are subject to change.

NFM Berkshire Picnic: Typically Saturday afternoon (4:00 PM - 8:00 PM) with free food, entertainment, and free shuttles from CHI Health Center. Food lines can reportedly stretch 60-90 minutes at peak.

Extended hours: In past years, open until 10:00 PM on AGM Saturday.

Confirm terms and registration directly with each retailer.

3.2 Wednesday, April 29

Wednesday is primarily an arrival and settling-in day. Some multi-day conferences hold welcome events Wednesday evening. Informal investor meetups often begin at downtown hotel bars and the Old Market district, sometimes announced on short notice.

PRO TIP

Wednesday is a strong networking day because people are fresh and not yet consumed by Saturday logistics. Make dinner reservations now for Thursday through Saturday - restaurants near the venue book up fast during meeting week.

3.3 Thursday, April 30

Thursday is when the week typically comes alive with conferences and dinners.

- **Location:** Omaha Marriott Downtown at the Capitol District
- **Cost:** \$125 members / \$175 non-members (as listed by the organizer)

- **Description:** A long-running dinner during meeting week featuring value investing speakers and networking.

Genius of Buffett Course (Day Session)

- **Time:** Full day
- **Location:** UNO campus
- **Registration:** geniusofbuffett.com

PRO TIP

Thursday evening often has more competing events than any other night. Pick one anchor event and commit - trying to hop between them usually wastes the evening.

3.4 Friday, May 1

Friday is typically a pivotal day: official Berkshire-affiliated events begin, the exhibition hall often opens for shopping, and major independent conferences take place.

- **Cost:** Free (extremely limited seats - registration expected to open March 2026)

- **Description:** A well-known investor conference where attendees are typically expected to present a stock pitch. A free livestream has been available in past years.

PRO TIP

If the exhibition hall is open Friday, it's typically much less crowded than Saturday - the best time to browse and talk with subsidiary representatives. Friday night also tends to have multiple competing events - pick one and commit.

3.5 Saturday, May 2 - Main AGM Day

This is the centerpiece of the entire week.

With the formal meeting wrapped by late afternoon, the evening opens up. The [Fireside Chat at the Hilton](#) (5:00 PM) is a popular way to decompress and talk shop before heading to dinner.

Typically 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM at Nebraska Furniture Mart (see NFM details in Section 3.1).

Borsheims - Saturday Shopping

10:00 AM - 5:00 PM (see Borsheims details in Section 3.1).

Vitaliy's Fireside Chat with Adam Anderson, CEO of Innovex

A relaxed, post-meeting conversation between Vitaliy Katsenelson and Innovex CEO Adam Anderson. The fireside format keeps things unscripted -- expect a wide-ranging discussion on capital allocation, building durable businesses, and the thinking behind long-term decision-making. The Hilton ballroom setting seats a few hundred, so it stays intimate enough for real back-and-forth with the audience.

- **Cost:** Free (RSVP required)

PRO TIP

The Fireside Chat is one of the few chances to hear a sitting CEO talk candidly about capital allocation in a small-group setting. RSVP early. These seats fill up.

3.6 Sunday, May 3

"Invest in Yourself" 5K Run

- **Expected date:** Sunday, May 3, 2026
- **Start time:** Typically 8:00 AM
- **Sponsored by:** Brooks Running (a Berkshire subsidiary)
- **Cost:** Paid entry (register early - prices have historically increased closer to the event)
- **Official site:** investinyourself5k.com
- **Race package pickup:** Typically Saturday at CHI Health Center
- All fitness levels welcome. Many participants walk.

Vitaliy's Intellectual Investor Breakfast and Q&A

One of the weekend's longest-running gatherings. Vitaliy hosts an open Q&A that ranges well beyond stock picks -- topics tend to span investing frameworks, Stoic philosophy, parenting, classical music, book recommendations, and whatever else the room wants to talk about. The Sunday-morning pace is unhurried, and the meet-and-greet afterward is a good chance to connect with other attendees.

- **11:00 AM-12:00 PM** - Meet and greet + book signing
- **Location:** Omaha Marriott Downtown at the Capitol District, 222 N 10th St, Omaha, NE 68102

PRO TIP

Arrive by 8:45 to grab a seat. The Q&A covers topics you won't hear at the main meeting: Stoic philosophy, book recommendations, investing frameworks, and whatever else the room wants to dig into.

PRO TIP

Sunday morning is typically the most relaxed part of the week and one of the best windows for meaningful conversations. The 5K is as much social as athletic.

3.7 Events FAQ

How do I register for side events? Most have their own registration pages. The Good Investing events calendar (good-investing.net) has historically maintained a curated list. Also monitor the [Corner of Berkshire & Fairfax forum](#) and search #BRK2026 on social media.

Are events free? It varies. Official Berkshire-affiliated events (AGM, exhibition hall, NFM gathering, Borsheims shopping) have historically been free with credentials. Independent events range from free to several thousand dollars.

Can non-shareholders attend side events? Generally yes - most independent conferences, dinners, and meetups don't require credentials. Credentials are typically needed for the AGM itself, the exhibition hall, and official Borsheims shareholder events.

Dress code? Casual to business casual for nearly all events.

4. The Main AGM Day

4.1 How to Ask a Question

- **Microphone drawing:** Floor microphones are stationed throughout the arena. Drawings for microphone positions begin at 8:15 AM.
- **Pre-submit questions by email:** Send questions to berkshirequestions@cnbc.com. CNBC journalists select and read pre-submitted questions during the Q&A.
- Keep your question short, specific, and focused on Berkshire's business. Clarity beats cleverness.

4.2 Getting to the CHI Health Center

Recommended arrival times (based on past attendee experience):

- **For an excellent seat:** 3:00-4:00 AM
- **For a decent seat:** 5:30-6:00 AM
- **To be in the building:** 7:00 AM when doors typically open (overflow seating with video screens available)

Parking (based on recent venue and meeting guidance):

- Surface lots: ~\$10 / Garages: ~\$15 / Bus/RV/trailer: ~\$25
- Lots have typically opened very early on meeting day

Shuttles: In recent years, complimentary loops have run between select downtown hotels and the venue (~6:30-9:00 AM), with CHI-to-NFM routes in the afternoon and evening.

Walking: The venue is walkable from most downtown hotels. The Hilton Omaha is connected via skybridge.

Rideshare: Uber and Lyft available. Expect surge pricing Saturday morning and after the meeting.

Confirm parking rates, shuttle routes, and schedules with official meeting materials.

 **PRO TIP**

If you're staying downtown, walking is often faster than driving after the meeting. The north entrance to the CHI Health Center has tended to be less crowded.

4.3 What Can You Bring?

Based on recent years (confirm with the official 2026 guide): small bags and purses have been permitted with security screening (no large luggage). Phones and tablets allowed; video recording prohibited. Concession stands operate inside. Pack a portable battery, light layer, and minimal metal to speed through security.

 **PRO TIP**

Plan for 4-6 hours seated. Eat a real breakfast before entering.

4.4 Getting a Good Seat

- **Floor level (100-level):** Most coveted. Requires very early arrival.
- **200-level:** Elevated with clear sightlines. Still a great experience.
- **Overflow rooms:** Large screens when the main arena fills.

When doors open, there's typically a rush for the best seats. If you're in a group, designate someone to secure seats. Review the CHI Health Center seating map in advance.

5. Exhibition Hall

The exhibition hall inside the CHI Health Center is a large-scale showcase of Berkshire subsidiaries - part trade show, part shopping experience, part investor education.

Friday, May 1	Noon - 5:00 PM
Saturday (meeting day)	7:00 AM - 4:00 PM

Notable exhibitors in recent years have included: See's Candies, Brooks Running, Fruit of the Loom, Borsheims, BNSF Railway, Benjamin Moore, Clayton Homes, Duracell, Forest River, GEICO, Jazwares (Squishmallows), Johns Manville, Lubrizol, Marmon Holdings, NetJets, Oriental Trading, Pampered Chef, Pilot Company, Shaw Industries, and many others.

Shareholder discounts have been available on many products. New Berkshire-themed memorabilia items are typically introduced each year and limited-stock items can sell out quickly.

Shopping tips:

- Walk the full hall once before buying anything.

- Identify large items early and ask about on-site shipping (which has recently closed Friday by 4 PM, Saturday by 3 PM).
- If you care about limited items, shop early in the weekend.

 **PRO TIP**

Budget 2-3 hours. Friday is the best day for a relaxed experience. Bring extra luggage space - shipping from Omaha can be expensive.

6. Things to Do in Omaha

Restaurants & Steakhouses

Omaha has a notable concentration of steakhouses, and visiting one during meeting week has become a tradition for many attendees.

- **Gorat's Steakhouse** - 4917 Center St - Widely known as a Buffett favorite. Old-school Italian-American steakhouse. Reservations essential during meeting week. 402-551-3733.
- **Piccolo Pete's** - 2202 S. 20th St - Italian-American restaurant with steaks and pasta. (Confirm current operating status before visiting.)
- **Mahogany Prime Steakhouse** - Upscale fine dining in the Old Market area.
- **801 Chophouse** - Paxton Building downtown. High-end steaks and seafood.
- **Cascio's Steak House** - Old-school Italian-steakhouse in South Omaha.
- **Other highlights:** V. Mertz (fine dining, Old Market), Le Voltaire (French), Ahmad's Persian Cuisine.

 **PRO TIP**

Make steakhouse reservations at least two weeks in advance. Thursday and Saturday nights are the hardest to book.

Worth a Visit

The **Old Market District** (cobblestone streets, galleries, restaurants, nightlife) is the social heart of downtown during meeting week. **Henry Doorly Zoo** is consistently rated among the best in the country if you have a free afternoon. **Warren Buffett's house** at 5505 Farnam St in the Dundee neighborhood is a popular photo stop from the public sidewalk.

7. Getting Around

Airport: Eppley Airfield (OMA) - ~5 miles / 10 minutes from downtown. Direct flights from many major US hubs. Flight prices spike for meeting weekend - book 2-3 months in advance. The airport is undergoing construction; some amenities may be limited.

Ground transportation: Uber and Lyft are available throughout Omaha (expect surge pricing AGM Saturday). Complimentary shuttle loops between downtown hotels and the venue have been provided in recent years. A rental car is helpful if you want to visit NFM, Borsheims, or attractions outside downtown.

8. Planning Your Trip

Hotels

Book early. Downtown hotels near the CHI Health Center sell out well in advance and prices are at a premium.

Downtown (walking distance to CHI Health Center):

- **Hilton Omaha** - Connected to the venue via skybridge. Books out earliest.
- Courtyard by Marriott Downtown (101 S. 10th St)
- Hyatt Place Downtown (540 S. 12th St)
- Omaha Marriott Downtown at the Capitol District
- Kimpton Cottonwood Hotel
- Magnolia Hotel (1615 Howard St)
- Embassy Suites (555 S. 10th St)
- DoubleTree (1616 Dodge St)

West Omaha (near NFM/Borsheims, typically easier parking):

- Marriott Regency (10220 Regency Cir)
- Hampton Inn (11201 Davenport St)
- TownePlace Suites (10865 W. Dodge Rd)

Budget strategies: Airbnb/VRBO (some investor communities coordinate shared rentals), Council Bluffs, Iowa hotels (across the river, ~10-15 min, significantly cheaper), or Des Moines/Lincoln for the truly budget-conscious.

 **PRO TIP**

If you want the Hilton, book 6-12 months out. For other downtown hotels, 3-4 months. If you're attending multiple side events, the time savings from staying downtown is worth the premium.

Budget

A budget-conscious attendee staying at a less expensive hotel, eating modestly, and attending only free events can do the trip for roughly \$1,000-\$1,500. A premium experience with a downtown hotel, steakhouse dinners, conference tickets, and shopping can easily reach \$3,000-\$5,000+. The biggest controllable cost is impulse shopping - set a "fun budget" before you arrive.

Friday	Morning conference (VALUEx, Value Investor Conference, or Gabelli). Afternoon: credential pickup and exhibition hall. Evening: Borsheims shareholder shopping (6-8 PM).
Saturday	AGM Day. Arrive early. Full meeting. NFM gathering or steakhouse dinner.
Sunday	Brooks 5K (8 AM). Katsenelson breakfast (8:45 AM). Borsheims shopping (11 AM-4 PM). Depart.

Final Planning Checklist

- Purchase at least 1 share of BRK.B well before credential requests open (if not already a shareholder)
- Book hotel downtown as early as possible
- Request credentials as soon as forms become available (~mid-March)
- Store proof-of-ownership PDF and pack photo ID
- Make restaurant reservations 2+ weeks out
- Register for side events (conferences, dinners, 5K)
- Pick 1 anchor event per day to build your schedule around
- Plan Saturday morning logistics (arrival time, parking, seat strategy)
- Set a shopping budget before arriving
- Pack layers, comfortable shoes, rain jacket, and a portable charger

Leave open time for spontaneous meetups

The meeting is the center of gravity, but the weekend is the experience. Show up curious, organized, and open to conversation - Omaha tends to reward it.
